However, within a month we will run a consultative process within Holy Trinity Parish to see how people feel about having one Mass on Sunday morning at Bryndwr.

Weekday Mass times are as follows for both parishes

7am and 9am – Monday – Friday – Burnside
 9am – Monday, Thursday – Bryndwr
 5.30pm – Tuesday - Bryndwr
 12 noon – Wednesday – Bryndwr
 9am – Friday – St Albans Catholic School Library

There will be no 9.00am Mass at Bryndwr on a Saturday morning. Between the two parishes on a Saturday morning, there will be one 9.00am Mass at Burnside. Confessions will be held at both parishes on Saturday from 9.30am – 10.30am. This change will take effect on 9 February 2019
