

Year 5 and 6 Weekly Winter Sports Cost

We have been fortunate since 2019 to have been able to attend Winter Weekly Sports at no cost to our families due to successful grant applications which paid for the cost of buses to and from Hagley Park. This year our first grant application was unsuccessful, so we applied to another organisation for a grant, which was accepted during the term holidays. The funding will cover half of our students' transportation costs. \$35 will be added to your school account to cover the 50% of transportation to Weekly Winter Sports that was not covered by the grant funding.

(< \$5) if want to purchase


Dress: Students are encouraged to dress in
